Dr. Bill Cobb is a petroleum engineering consultant who specializes in waterflooding, pressure transient analysis, and property management. Cobb has 38 years experience in the petroleum industry including research, staff, and district positions for ARCO Oil and Gas. He has hands-on experience in the design, implementation, surveillance, and management of waterfloods in various waterflooding areas of North America as well as Australia, Africa, the Middle East, the North Sea, South America, and Southeast Asia. He headed oil and gas operations for Cornell Oil Company, an independent oil and gas company. For more than 25 years, Cobb has directed a petroleum consulting firm in Dallas.

Cobb served on the petroleum engineering staff at Mississippi State, where he taught reservoir engineering courses. He has conducted numerous one-week short courses on the subjects of waterflooding, pressure transient analysis, and petroleum economics.

Cobb has served on numerous committees for the SPE, including the Reservoir Engineering Program Committee, Publications Review Committee, Distinguished Author Series Committee, and Chairman of the Formation Evaluation Committee.

Dr. Cobb was the 2008 SPE President and he will continue to serve as a member of the Board of Directors until the end of 2009. Previously he served as Vice-President of Finance for SPE. He also served as a Distinguished Lecturer for the SPE in 1995. In 1999, he was presented with the SPE Reservoir Engineer Award. He is currently an adjunct professor of Petroleum Engineering at Texas A&M University.

Cobb received B.S. and M.S. degrees from Mississippi State University and a Ph.D. from Stanford University, all in petroleum engineering.
